

KCA Goals

Goal 1

We commit to an ongoing partnership with Holy Spirit to create a **new wineskin**.

"And no one puts new wine into old wineskins; otherwise the new wine will burst the skins and it will be spilled out, and the skins will be ruined. But new wine must be put into fresh wineskins." (Luke 5:37-38)

KCA is a safe and highly relational environment where Kingdom servant-leaders can learn and live Kingdom values and Kingdom culture, as we help each other to expand and establish God's Kingdom in our spheres of influence.

A new wineskin is **flexible**; it can take on whatever shape is best for the moment. What examples of new shapes have you seen or experienced?

A new wineskin is **not permanent**. Chuck Pierce suggests that most wineskins have a 7 year viability. Jesus never changes, but He loves to change things up in our lives. For what purposes?

A new wineskin is **unprecedented**. Jesus said that new wine must be put into fresh wineskins. How does this never before seen or experienced environment take the limits off Holy Spirit in what He wants to do through us?

Goal 2

EPH 4:1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,

EPH 4:2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, **showing tolerance** for one another in love,

EPH 4:3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

EPH 4:4 There is one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling;

EPH 4:5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism,

EPH 4:6 one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all.

EPH 4:7 ¶ But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.

Goal #2 = understanding not agreement

We commit to pursuing and protecting relationship when disagreement arises. We will not use "thus says the Lord" to intimidate anyone who disagrees with us.

Goal 3

ROM 12:10 Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor;

PHI 2:3 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves;

PHI 2:4 do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

EPH 5:21 and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ.

MAR 10:42 Calling them to Himself, Jesus said to them, "You know that those who are recognized as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them; and their great men exercise authority over them.

MAR 10:43 "But it is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant;

MAR 10:44 and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be slave of all.

MAR 10:45 "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Goal #3 = service not status

- We commit to relating to one another as sisters and brothers, fellow sons & daughters of our Papa God.
- We will not use titles or other hierarchical language to place ourselves above anyone.
- We commit to actively serving one another as the Spirit leads.

We are pioneering something here, and pioneers usually have a target on their back!

The Trinity's Perfect Plan: Body not Bureaucracy

EPH 1:22 And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church,

EPH 1:23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

EPH 4:11 And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers,

EPH 4:12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;

EPH 4:13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

Every leader's responsibility: equip, train, release

EPH 4:14 As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming;

EPH 4:15 but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ,

EPH 4:16 from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

Every believer's responsibility: connect and stay connected with other believers so we can serve and bless them, all as the Spirit leads,
